Measures 16-18: Flute (Fl.) has whole rests. Piano (Pno.) has whole rests. Harp (Hrp.) plays a descending eighth-note scale in measure 16, followed by a sustained block chord in measures 17 and 18.

Measures 19-21: Flute (Fl.) has whole rests. Piano (Pno.) has whole rests in measure 19, then plays eighth-note chords in measures 20 and 21. Harp (Hrp.) plays a sustained block chord in measure 19, then a descending eighth-note scale in measures 20 and 21.

Measures 22-24: Flute (Fl.) has whole rests. Piano (Pno.) plays eighth-note chords in measures 22 and 23, then a whole note chord in measure 24. Harp (Hrp.) plays a descending eighth-note scale in measures 22 and 23, then a whole note chord in measure 24.

Measures 25-27: Flute (Fl.) has whole rests. Piano (Pno.) plays eighth-note chords in measures 25 and 26, then a whole note chord in measure 27. Harp (Hrp.) plays a descending eighth-note scale in measures 25 and 26, then a whole note chord in measure 27.

Measures 28-30: Flute (Fl.) has whole rests. Piano (Pno.) has whole rests. Harp (Hrp.) plays a descending eighth-note scale in measure 28, followed by a sustained block chord in measures 29 and 30.

Measures 31-33. Flute (Fl.) has whole rests. Piano (Pno.) has whole rests in measures 31 and 32, then eighth-note chords in measure 33. Harp (Hrp.) has a dense block chord in measure 31, a similar chord in measure 32, and a descending eighth-note scale in measure 33.

Measure 34. Flute (Fl.) has a whole rest. Piano (Pno.) has a half note in the first half and a quarter-note chord in the second half. Harp (Hrp.) has a quarter-note scale in the first half and a whole rest in the second half.
